CAMRA Finances

There are significant challenges to the organisation ahead. On the back of a £350,000 loss from this year's GBBF and Winter GBBF, a decision has been made to cancel those events for next year. The printed Beer Magazine will only be available online. Other cost savings are being sought.

Saving Expenditure

- Chris Charters, RD, outlined in an email some ways the RDs can make expenditure savings and invited all his Branches to suggest what they can do.
- No easy solutions from branch level but it was thought that this analysis should come from HQ as they would know the detail via Branch expense requests.

CBOB (Champion Beer of Britain)

- The process is now open for members to nominate up to five beers in each of the 12 different CAMRA beer style categories access and explanation is available from the CAMRA website homepage, once signed in.
- Voting ends at the end of October.

- For the future, there has been a proposal that the CBOB nomination process mirrors that of the GBG nomination process i.e.via the Branches, the Area and then the Regions route.
